JEREMIAH 29:13 -

"You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart."



PowerPoint: God promises to reveal Himself to Christfollowers who seek Him fully.





Q CONTEXT:

In this passage, the Israelites are in exile, and God is reassuring them through the prophet Jeremiah that they will find Him when they seek Him wholeheartedly. This promise is not just for them but for all who are in search of God's presence.



SUMMARY:

God promises that when Christ followers seek Him with their whole heart, they will find Him. Surging ahead in our spiritual lives requires a dedicated, whole-hearted pursuit of God, prioritizing His presence above all else. When we make seeking Him our priority, we will experience His intimate nearness and fulfillment.



STORY:

A young man named Denzel had always felt disconnected from God, even though he attended church. He realized that his heart wasn't fully committed and was distracted by the pursuit of success. One evening, he decided to devote an entire day to prayer and fasting, seeking God earnestly. By the end of the day, he felt a peace and presence of God like never before. Through his intentional pursuit, God revealed Himself, deepening Denzel's faith and reshaping his priorities.

▼ DRIVE





WHOLEHEARTED PURSUIT:

Commit to seeking God with all your heart, prioritizing time for prayer, worship, and meditation on His Word to deepen your relationship with Him.



INTROSPECTION:

Reflect on any distractions in your life that hinder your full devotion to God, and remove those distractions to make room for deeper intimacy with Him.



PERSISTENT FAITH:

Continue to seek God even when answers don't come immediately, trusting that He will reveal Himself in His perfect timing.



REFUEL



Lord, I come before You with a heart that desires to seek You wholeheartedly. I confess that at times I have been distracted by the things of this world, but today, I choose to focus my heart and mind on You. I long to know You more deeply and to experience Your presence in a real and transformative way. As I seek You, I trust in Your promise that I will find You. Draw me closer to You, Lord, and ignite a passion in my soul to seek You above all else. In Jesus' name, Amen.







EZEKIEL 36:26-27 -

"I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you."



PowerPoint: God transforms our hearts and gives His Spirit to guide us.





Q CONTEXT:

God is speaking to the Israelites, promising a new covenant after their exile. He tells them that He will give them a new heart and put His Spirit within them. This transformation would empower them to live according to His laws.



SUMMARY:

God promises to give Christ-followers a new heart and His Spirit to guide them. Surging ahead spiritually involves cooperating with the Holy Spirt. As Christ-followers allow Him to renew their hearts, believers are empowered by the Holy Spirit to live according to His will and bear fruit for His Kingdom.



STORY:

Serena, once burdened by bitterness and unforgiveness, struggled to find peace. One night, she prayed earnestly for God to change her heart. Over time, she noticed subtle changes in her reactions and thoughts. Where there once was anger, there was now forgiveness. Where there once was fear, there was peace. Serena realized that God had transformed her heart, enabling her to live a more compassionate and Christlike life.

DRIVE





EMBRACE TRANSFORMATION:

Allow God to transform your heart, replacing old habits and mindsets with His pure desires and intentions.



WALK IN THE SPIRIT:

Rely on the Holy Spirit for guidance and strength to live in accordance with God's will, developing a Christlike character.



CULTIVATE SPIRITUAL RENEWAL:

Engage in practices that promote spiritual renewal, such as confession, prayer, and reading scripture, to align your heart more closely with God's purposes.



REFUEL



Father, thank You for Your promise to give me a new heart and a new spirit. I ask that You transform me from the inside out. Remove the old, broken parts of me and replace them with Your pure and loving heart. Fill me with Your Holy Spirit so that I can walk in Your ways and fulfill Your will. JOHN 6:44 -

"No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws them."



PowerPoint: God draws us into a relationship with Him.





Q CONTEXT:

In this passage, Jesus explains to the crowd that no one can come to Him unless the Father draws them. It emphasizes God's active role in bringing people to faith.



SUMMARY:

Spiritual growth is not a self-driven effort but one initiated by God. Surging ahead in our spiritual lives requires recognizing that God draws us near to Him. Our response to His calling opens the door to greater intimacy and spiritual maturity.



STORY:

Michael had always been skeptical about faith, but over time, he began to feel a strong pull toward Jesus. He couldn't explain it, but something inside him was drawing him closer to God. One Sunday, during a sermon on God's love, Michael finally surrendered to the drawing he had been feeling for months. He gave his life to Christ and began to experience the transformation that came from answering God's call.

RECOGNIZE DIVINE INITIATIVE:

Acknowledge that your faith is a result of God's drawing you closer to Himself, and be grateful for His active role in your salvation.



PRAY FOR OTHERS:

Pray for those who have not yet been drawn to Christ, asking God to open their hearts to His love and truth.



RESPOND WILLINGLY:

When you sense God's drawing, respond with openness and surrender, willing to follow His lead wherever He directs you.



REFUEL



Lord, I thank You that You have drawn me into Your presence. I recognize that my faith is not by my own strength, but by Your grace and the work of Your Spirit in my life. I pray for those around me who have not yet come to You. Please draw them near and open their hearts to Your love. I am humbled by Your grace, and I commit to following You, knowing that You are the one who calls me. Help me to trust in Your timing and work in my life. In Jesus' name, Amen.





PHILIPPIANS 2:13 -

"For it is God who works in you to will and to act in order to fulfill his good purpose."



PowerPoint: God provides the desire and power to follow Him.





Q CONTEXT:

Paul writes to the Philippians, encouraging them to live in a manner worthy of the gospel. He reminds them that it is God who works in them to will and act according to His purpose.



SUMMARY:

God is actively working within Christfollowers, giving Christ-followers both the desire and the ability to live according to His will. Surging ahead spiritually requires surrendering to His work within us, trusting that He equips us for the purpose He has set before us.



STORY:

Jada was a busy professional, feeling disconnected from her purpose. She decided to step into leadership at her church, not knowing exactly how she would manage. As she trusted God, He gave her the desire and energy to serve. Over time, she discovered new strengths and abilities she hadn't known she had, realizing that it was God working within her, enabling her to live out His purpose for her life.

▼ DRIVE





TRUST IN GOD'S WORK:

Recognize that God is at work in your life, shaping your desires and actions to align with His purpose for you.



SURRENDER TO GOD'S WILL:

Yield your will to God's, allowing Him to guide your decisions, goals, and ambitions to align with His kingdom work.



ACT WITH PURPOSE:

Be proactive in following God's guidance, taking intentional actions to fulfill His calling and further His kingdom on earth.

Heavenly Father, I thank You that You are at work within me, both to will and to act according to Your purpose. I recognize that without Your help, I am nothing. 2 CORINTHIANS 5:17 -

"If anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"



PowerPoint: God makes us a new creation in Christ.

▼ FUEL



Q CONTEXT:

Paul explains to the Corinthians that anyone in Christ is a new creation. The old has gone, and the new has come, emphasizing the transformative power of God's work in believers.



SUMMARY:

When we accept Christ, we are made new. Surging ahead spiritually involves embracing our new identity in Christ and leaving behind the old ways of living. Our new creation status empowers us to live a transformed/new life, reflecting Christ's love and righteousness.



STORY:

After years of struggling with addiction, Tim gave his life to Christ. At first, he didn't feel much different, but over time, he began to notice his old habits and desires slipping away. His relationships healed, his outlook on life changed, and he became passionate about helping others overcome what he once faced. Tim's transformation was a living testimony that the old had gone, and the new had come.

▼ DRIVE





CELEBRATE YOUR IDENTITY IN CHRIST:

Embrace your new identity in Christ, understanding that your past mistakes and sins no longer define you.



LIVE OUT THE NEW CREATION:

Walk in the freedom of being a new creation, reflecting the love and grace of God in all aspects of your life.



GROW IN HOLINESS:

Pursue a life of holiness, continually putting off old behaviors and embracing the new, Christlike characteristics that God has given you.

Lord, I thank You for the gift of new life in Christ. I celebrate the fact that I am a new creation in You. Thank You for forgiving me and for transforming me into something new. Help me to live out this new identity every day. I want to put aside the old ways and embrace the life You've called me to. Teach me to walk in the power of my new identity in Christ. ROMANS 8:15 -

"The Spirit you received brought about your adoption to sonship. And by him we cry, 'Abba, Father."



PowerPoint: God gives us His Spirit and adopts us as His children.

▼ FUEL



Q CONTEXT:

Paul writes to the Romans, assuring them that they have received the Spirit of adoption, which allows them to cry out to God as their "Abba, Father."



SUMMARY:

Through the Holy Spirit, we have been adopted into God's family, and we can confidently approach Him as our Father. Surging ahead spiritually involves embracing the intimacy and security of being God's beloved children, knowing that He is always with us. The challenge is to live like we are His children.



STORY:

Rachel had never experienced the love of a father, so she struggled to understand God's love for her. One evening, as she prayed, she felt God whispering to her heart, "You are My daughter." From that moment on, Rachel began to see God as her loving Father, knowing that He would never leave her and would always care for her. Her heart filled with peace, and her relationship with God deepened.

CULTIVATE INTIMACY WITH GOD:

SUMMARY:

STORY:

SUMMARY:

Surging ahead in our spiritual lives requires embracing the truth that God will never leave us. His constant presence gives us the assurance and strength to persevere through challenges. We can move forward with confidence, knowing that He is always with us, guiding and supporting us. No matter what your feelings, guilt, shame, or feelings God will never leave you!



STORY:

James had spent years battling loneliness, feeling like he was always on his own. One day, as he walked through a difficult season, he felt the weight of God's promise that He would never leave him. That truth brought a sense of peace he hadn't known before, and James began to step forward with renewed courage, trusting that God's presence would always sustain him.

▼ DRIVE





EMBRACE GOD'S FAITHFULNESS:

Live with the confidence that God will never leave or abandon you, no matter your circumstances.



REST IN HIS PRESENCE:

Find peace in God's constant presence, trusting that He is always with you, providing support and guidance.



SHARE HIS ASSURANCE WITH OTHERS:

Encourage others with the truth that God is faithful, especially those who are struggling or feeling abandoned.

SUMMARY:

God has chosen and appointed us to bear fruit for His kingdom. Surging ahead spiritually means living intentionally, knowing that God has a purpose for us. As we remain in Him and live out His calling, our lives will bear fruit that glorifies Him and impacts the world.



STORY:

Mary struggled to find purpose in her work, feeling disconnected from her faith. One day, while reflecting on John 15:16, she realized that God had chosen her to bear fruit right where she was. She began to intentionally serve others and share God's love in her workplace. Her actions had a ripple effect, drawing others closer to Christ and giving her a deeper sense of fulfillment.

SUMMARY:

The Holy Spirit pours God's love into our hearts, empowering us to live in the freedom of His love. Surging ahead spiritually means allowing this divine love to fill us, transform us, and overflow to others, creating a life marked by compassion, hope, and grace.



STORY:

Oprah had been struggling with bitterness toward a close friend who had wronged her. One night, she prayed for God to help her forgive, and in that moment, she felt His love pour into her heart. It was as if the hurt melted away. The transformation was profound, and Oprah began to reflect that love to others, fostering deeper relationships and spiritual growth.

RECEIVE GOD'S LOVE:

STORY:

Sammy had a vision to start a community outreach program, but the obstacles seemed insurmountable. He didn't know where the resources or support would come from. As he stepped out in faith, he saw God provide in miraculous ways—people, finances, and opportunities that far exceeded what he had imagined. Sammy realized that God's power working through him made the impossible possible.

EXPAND YOUR FAITH:

Believe that God is able to do more than you could ever imagine, and trust Him to exceed your expectations in your life.

Q CONTEXT:

David declares that the Lord is his Shepherd, providing guidance, rest, and restoration. The imagery of God as a Shepherd conveys His care and leadership in the lives of His people.



SUMMARY:

Surging ahead spiritually involves trusting that God, as our Shepherd, will provide for our needs, restore our souls, and guide us along the right paths. His leadership leads to peace, purpose, and spiritual vitality.



STORY:

After years of feeling lost and directionless, Rachel found herself in a place of spiritual exhaustion. She turned to Psalm 23, meditating on God as her Shepherd. Over time, she felt her soul restored, and her trust in His guidance grew stronger.. As she followed His lead, her life took on new meaning, and she found peace in His care.

FIND REST IN GOD:

SUMMARY:

God's mercies are never-ending, and each day brings a fresh opportunity for spiritual renewal. Surging ahead in our spiritual life means trusting that God's mercy is available to us every morning, no matter our struggles, and it empowers us to keep moving forward with hope.



STORY:
